## IMAX (70mm) LARGE FORMAT EXPERIENCE

As a Director of Photography using large format cameras, I am fully conversant with the unique optical and technical challenges associated with shooting Imax and Imax Dome footage in both the 15/70 and 8/70 formats.

I was commissioned over two years as Co/Director of Photography to shoot the Imax film “**Antarctica**” and for this role I underwent extensive factory training in the operation, servicing, troubleshooting and maintenance of the Imax camera systems to be used on the film. Initially I was 2<sup>nd</sup> unit DOP but was elevated to Principal Director of Photography for the second half of the production.

During the creation of this motion picture, we worked under some of the most extreme sub zero and miserable conditions imaginable to produce the film. Due to our reduced crew numbers and isolation, I personally maintained and serviced the two Imax camera packages (including all accessories) in Antarctica during this period.

As the Director of Photography and camera operator, I not only shot substantial sequences for the film topside, but my role also required capturing unique underwater footage, which I shot during more than 70 dives under the ice during the eight months spent filming in Antarctica.

In recent years I have visited the Imax factory numerous times to complete further practical training courses and to keep abreast of the latest developments in large format cinematography. Each visit also allowed me to maintain my close professional working relationship with my associates at the Imax camera department.

I have sound hands-on experience with most of the cameras and accessories in the Imax inventory including the MSM 9801 system, the IW5 and IW5A camera systems and the rugged MKII camera package. I am also familiar with the Imax HD 48 fps, the 60 fps camera and the IW8 96 fps hi-speed camera systems.
